We started the morning getting to know our fellow travelers. We welcomed Rev. Mary Westfall (Coastlands Presbytery) to lead us in worship, which included a live enactment of the covenant Ruth & Naomi made together.









Vote on Merger Recommendation Was Unanimous!

Both presbyteries moved the recommendation. Following the best parliamentary process our co-moderators could handle on the fly, we seconded, debated, amended, and eventually approved -- by a unanimous vote from both presbyteries -- a motion to request authority from the Synod of the Pacific to develop a Plan of Merger, targeting January 1, 2026 to complete the formal merger. The Synod will consider this request at its October Assembly.

The Journey Begins

Both presbyteries also approved the formation of a Merger Coordination Task Force to work together on the Plan of Merger details. As the work proceeds, a new name will be selected through a contest, so start imagining!
